

Components of the System

- 1. Removable Padding
- 2. Upper Anchoring Strap: For securing the seating system to the back of the chair.
- 3. User Safety Straps.
- 4. Seat Unit (Pommel): Includes a leg separator, an internal angle, and a universal connector.
- 5. Lower Anchoring Strap: For securing the support to the seat of the chair.
- 6. Universal Connector.





Installation on chair


Placement: The system should be installed on a wide and stable seat whose center of gravity is not affected by the installation of the support.

Attaching the Straps:

- Align the front of the seat with the front of the chair allowing 90 Deg angle for legs.
- Connect and tighten the lower anchoring strap to the seat of the chair.
- Connect and tighten the upper anchoring strap to the back of the chair.
- After the initial connection, tighten the lower anchoring strap well, and then tighten the upper anchoring strap.

- After installing the system, check that all straps are well-tensioned.
- Ensure that the system is securely connected and does not sway. To test stability, hold the chair with one hand and try to move the system with the other hand.
 Gap Filling: If a gap forms between the support and the back of the chair, fill the space with a cushion to prevent tipping.







Floor Placement and Anti-Tipping Installation

Place the system on the floor, ensuring that there are no objects interfering between the system and the floor.

Connecting the Dedicated Anti-Tipping Device:

- The dedicated anti-tipping device should be connected using a specific "key."
- After assembly, tighten the key securely.

- The anti-tipping device must be installed before seating the user in the system.
- If there is a risk of the user tipping sideways, use a wider dedicated anti-tipping device.





Installation of Supplementary Accessories

1. Head Support:

- Install the head support when the seating support is in place.
- Attach the head support before seating the user.
- Use specific "keys" to connect the back of the support to the rail, and the head support to the rail.
- Tighten the keys well to prevent wobbling.
- Warning: While adjusting the head support to the desired height, hold the user's head until the installation and securing of the head support is complete.

2. Leg Rest:

- Install the leg rest when the seating system is in place.
- Attach the leg rest before seating the user.
- Use specific "keys" to connect the leg rest to the rail, and then attach the rail to the body of the system using the front connector.
- Tighten the keys well to prevent wobbling.

3. Rear Anti-Tipping Device (Floor Seating):

• See the "Installation as a Floor Seating System" page in this booklet.

- Install all equipment before seating the user.
- Size adjustments should be made when the seating system is installed and stable.
- Ensure that the rail for attaching accessories is long enough.
- Ensure that the keys are tightened sufficiently to prevent "wobbling."
- Before any installation, ensure that the connection is correct and complete.







Positioning the User

Securing the User in the Chair with the Seating System's Safety Straps:

- Seat the user fully into the seating system, ensuring that their back and buttocks are close to the back of the system.
- Secure the user with the safety straps (anchoring and chest straps).

- Only seat users in the seating system for whom the system has been tested and found suitable.
- Do not leave the system and the user unattended.
- Ensure that the safety straps are not loose.
- Dress the user in appropriate clothing that does not interfere with the securing of the safety straps.







Maintenance and Cleaning

System's Body

Maintenance and Cleaning Instructions for the Body of the System (ABS Plastic Frame):


- Clean the body of the system using a sponge or cloth with lukewarm water and mild soap only.
- It can be dried with a towel.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents; do not use substances based on acetone.
- Do not leave the product exposed to the sun for an extended period.

Padding

- To remove dirt, dust, and sand, use a vacuum cleaner.
- To remove a fresh stain, quickly use a damp cloth before the stain dries.







